



Second circular and call for papers

The GADAM Centre of Excellence invites you to participate in the 10th International Conference “Methods of Absolute Chronology” to take place on 22-25th April 2010 in Gliwice, Poland.

INFORMATION FOR PARTICIPANTS AND AUTHORS

If you wish to participate in the conference, please register on-line if you have not done so (web-site: <http://www.carbon14.pl/10thMAC>) before 15th March 2010. Authors of oral or poster presentations are requested to submit abstracts of their presentations. Abstracts should be submitted in English via our web site by 15th March 2010. The length of the abstract should be approximately 500 words (not more than one page) and the abstract must be sufficiently informative to allow a fair evaluation of the intended presentation. The abstracts will be printed in a book of abstracts. Each abstract should contain: the title, the author's name(s) and affiliation(s) and the text (figures and references are not allowed). The author should also suggest the preferred form of presentation (oral or poster) but the Scientific Committee will make the final acceptance and decision concerning the presentation form after the evaluation of abstracts.

The proceedings of the conference will be published in *Geochronometria* and only papers presented by the author at the conference (in either form) will be considered for publication. The papers will be refereed according to the rules of the Journal (see http://www.geochronometria.pl/pdf/Instr_for_Authors.pdf). We encourage the authors to submit the manuscripts during the conference – we will make the effort to publish these papers in 2010.

This year the GADAM Centre of Excellence concludes the Marie-Curie Transfer of Knowledge project ATIS (**A**bsolute **T**ime Scales and **I**sotope **S**tudies for Investigating Events in Earth and Human History, atis.polsl.pl) and one of the oral sessions will present the scientific results and developments obtained during this project. The conference is accompanied by a meeting of ATIS Scientific Board.

During the conference a workshop entitled “Isotope Methods for Modern and Past Environment” will take place.

One of the oral sessions will be dedicated to the applications of the isotopic methods in industry and participants are encouraged to submit abstracts concerning these issues.

During conference in the main conference hall there will be a dedicated place (publication exchange) for the participants to present their scientific papers in the form of off-prints of their publications or similar. Participants who would like to present off-prints are kindly welcome to do so.

The conference will be held at the Silesian University of Technology Education and Congress Centre (Gliwice, Poland).

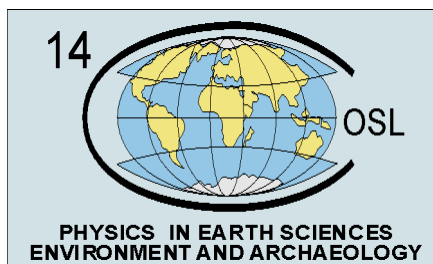
